

Proposed Constitution Amendments

Computer Engineering Association proposes the following Constitution amendment.

The purpose of this amendment is to maintain the administrative operations of the Association in case of personnel changes that should not affect Executive Committee members (hereafter referred as “Ex-Co”) continuing their term of office.

The proposed amendment is expected to be presented at the First Extraordinary General Meeting of session 2007-2008 for voting.

Proposed amendment:

4.6 Vote of Confidence

Any Executive Committee Member who ceases to be an undergraduate of Computer Engineering of the University of Hong Kong during his term of office in a session may continue to hold office till the end of that session upon a vote of confidence being passed to him by the Association.

This article is proposed to be added to the Constitution under the session The Executive Committee. It indicates an Ex-Co may continue his term of office even if he is no longer an undergraduate of Computer Engineering of the University of Hong Kong (hereafter referred to as “CE undergraduate”).

The current Constitution only grants a CE undergraduate the eligibility to be an Ordinary Member of the Association. Therefore, if an Ex-Co, who must also be an Ordinary Member at the same time, discontinues his studies as a CE undergraduate will lose his eligibility to be an Ex-Co of the Association unless a Vote of Confidence is passed to him.
